Parent Portal Acceptable Use Policy

Davenport Community School District has developed a Parent Portal as a means to further promote educational excellence and to enhance communication with parents. The Portal allows parents to view their child's unofficial school records through a web browser at any time and from anywhere there is an Internet connection. The Portal is available to every parent or guardian of a student enrolled in Davenport schools.

Access to the parent portal is allowed only after reading and accepting the Acceptable Use Policy, and returning page 2 of this document. Upon receipt of the signed Acceptable Use Policy the parent will be issued a required activation code and instructions on how to go online and set up a Portal account to access their child's records.

Parents will have access to the following unofficial data about their child:

- Attendance
- Class assignments for current classes. Parents can expect that grades for an assignment will be posted within seven days after the assignment has been turned in. This will give teachers adequate time to grade all student work and post the scores.
- Student Fee Summary
- Student Schedule
- Student Report Card
- Grad Planner for HS Students

Please read the Acceptable Use Policy below and sign and this document to your child's school office.

- Parents will not share their password with anyone, including their children.
- Parents will not attempt to harm or destroy data of another user, school or district network, or the Internet.
- Parents will not use the Portal for any illegal activity including violation of Data Privacy laws. Anyone found to be violating the laws would be subject to civil and/or criminal prosecution.
- Parents will not access data or any account owned by another parent.
- Parents who identify a security problem with the Parent Portal must notify Judy Nixon or Cheryl Scott at (563-336-3804) immediately, without demonstrating the problem to anyone else.
- All data that is accessible on the Parent Portal is unofficial. This includes, but is not limited to, attendance, transcripts, and class assignments.
- Parents who are identified as a security risk to the Parent Portal will be denied access to the Parent Portal.

I have read the Parent Portal Acceptable Use Policy and agree to abide by these regulations. I understand that if I violate any terms of this policy that I may lose my privilege to use the Parent Portal, and may be liable for civil and/or criminal consequences.
