MOTION: Director Howard moved the Board hold a closed session as provided in section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Kleinschmidt seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Howard, Kleinschmidt, Zamora, Low, Imming, Hester, and Hollonbeck. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board moved into the closed session for an expulsion hearing remaining in the Executive Conference Room at 6:06 PM.

The Board returned to open session in the Executive Conference Room by consensus at 6:50 PM.

6:50 PM EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #9913

Director Low stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9913 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Low moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9913:

1. that Student Case #9913 be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
2. that Student Case #9913 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion other than the site of the alternative programming;
3. that Student Case #9913 receive services at the Harrison Street Program for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
4. that Student Case #9913 return to the Administrative Advisory Council for appropriate placement before the beginning of the 2000-2001 school year

Director Zamora seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Low, Zamora, Hester, Howard, Imming, and Hollonbeck. Nay, Kleinschmidt. Motion carried.

EXCLUSION OF STUDENT CASE #9914

Director Imming stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #9914 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Imming moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #9914:

1. that Student Case #9914 be excluded from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
2. that Student Case #9914 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the exclusion other than the site of the alternative programming
3. that Student Case #9914 receive services at the Eastern Avenue School (West Campus) for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
4. that Student Case #9914 return to the Administrative Advisory Council for appropriate placement before the beginning of the 2000-2001 school year

Director Low seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Imming, Low, Zamora, Kleinschmidt, Hester, Howard, and Hollonbeck. Motion carried unanimously.
