EXCLUSION OF STUDENT CASE #0122

Director Low stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0122, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Low moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0122:

- 1) that Student Case #0122 be excluded from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2001-02 school year;
- 2) that Student Case #0122 will receive services at the Harrison Street Program;
- 3) that Student Case #0122 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the exclusion other than the site of the alternative programming; and
- 4) that prior to the beginning of the 2002-2003 school year, the Administrative Advisory Council will meet to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0122.

Director Zamora seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Low, Zamora, Hunter, Clewell, Imming, and Hester. Motion carried unanimously.

EXCLUSION OF STUDENT CASE #0123

Director Imming stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0123, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Imming moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0123:

- 1) that Student Case #0123 be excluded from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2001-02 school year;
- 2) that Student Case #0123 will receive alternative services at the Harrison Street Program during the time of the exclusion;
- 3) that Student Case #0123 will receive Anger Management classes;
- 4) that Student Case #0123 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the exclusion other than the site of the alternative programming; and
- 5) that prior to the beginning of the 2002-2003 school year, the Administrative Advisory Council will meet to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0123.

Director Low seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Imming, Low, Zamora, Hunter, Clewell, and Hester. Motion carried unanimously.

EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #0124

Director Low stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0124, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Low moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0124:

- 1) that Student Case #0124 be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2001-02 school year;
- 2) that Student Case #0124 will receive alternative services during the time of her expulsion at the Harrison Street Program;
- 3) that Student Case #0124 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion other than the Harrison Street site; and
- 4) that the Administrative Advisory Council will meet prior to the beginning of the 2002-2003 school year to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0124.

Director Zamora seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Low, Zamora, Hunter, Imming, Clewell, and Hester. Motion carried.

EXCLUSION OF STUDENT CASE #0125

Director Imming stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0125, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Imming moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0125:

- 1) that Student Case #0125 be excluded from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2001-02 school year;
- 2) that Student Case #0125 will receive alternative services at the Harrison Street Program;
- 3) that Student Case #0125 will receive counseling services at CADS;
- 4) that Student Case #0125 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the exclusion other than the site of the alternative programming; and
- 5) that prior to the beginning of the 2002-2003 school year, the Administrative Advisory Council will meet to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0125.

Director Hunter seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Imming, Hunter, Low, Clewell, Zamora, and Hester. Motion carried unanimously.
