EXCLUSION OF STUDENT CASE #0237

Director Clewell stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0237, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Clewell moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to exclude Student Case #0237:

1. That Student Case #0237 will be excluded from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2002-2003 school year;
2. That Student Case #0237 will receive services provided at the Harrison Street Program during the time of the exclusion;
3. That Student Case #0237 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the exclusion, other than the site of the alternative programming;
4. That Student Case #0237 will return to the Administrative Advisory Council for appropriate placement before the beginning of the 2003-2004 school year.

Director Hunter seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Clewell, Hunter, Hanson, Roberson, and Low. Motion carried unanimously.
