MOTION: Director Guard moved the Board hold a closed session as provided in section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Tupper seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Guard, Tupper, DeFauw, and Zamora. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board moved into closed session in the Superintendent's Office at 12:05 PM. The mother of the student was present for the closed session hearing but the student was not present.

The Board returned to open session at by consensus at 12:42 PM to take action in the Superintendent's office.

EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #0403

Director Tupper stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0403 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Tupper moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0403:

1. That Student Case #0403 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2004-2005 school year and through the first semester of the 2005-2006 school year;
2. That Student Case #0403 will receive alternative services or programming during the second quarter of the 2005-2006 school year;
3. That Student Case #0403 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event (including athletic events) where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion, other than the site of any alternative services or programming; and
4. That Student Case #0403 will return to the Administrative Advisory Council for appropriate placement before the beginning of the second semester of the 2005-2006 school year.

Director Guard seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows. Ayes: Tupper, Guard, and DeFauw. Abstaining: Zamora. Motion carried.
